
## **Female Reproductive System**

- 1. endometrium is reabsorbed by the uterus, vagina permits only a certain time for mating 4. neck of the uterus which opens into the vagina 5. connect ovaries to the uterus 13. embryonic hormone that maintains secretion of pregesterone and estrogen

- 15. thin piece of tissue that covers the vaginal opening 16. thick, muscular organ that expands during pregnancy 18. slender skin folds next to vestibule

- 2. fetus grows about 30cm and begins to be active
- 3. encloses and protects the labia minora and vestibule
- 6. glands located near the vaginal opening, secretes mucus into the vestibule 7. thin-walled chamber that serves as the bith canal

- 7. thin-waited chalmer that serves as the bit canal
  8. fetus grows to 50 cm, birth of baby happens
  9. when almost all organs of an embryo form
  10. short shaft supporting a rounded glands, or head
  11. the endometrium is shed during this cycle
  12. inner lining of uterus that is supplied with blood vessels
- 13. estrogen, progesterone GnRH, FSH, LH

- 14. forms 3 polar bodies and 1 ovum17. Follicular phase, ovulatory phase, luteal phase19. contains follicles that are released during ovulation
