## MUSIC

1. 2 - pocket folder
2. Pencils
3. Headphones
4. USB Jump Drive - optional for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders
5. Red pen

## WELLNESS

1. Any non-marking tennis shoes
2. P.E. uniforms are not required. Shorts and a tee shirt or sweats are acceptable.
3. Cotton socks
4. Recommend sweats for outdoors activities.
5. 2-pocket folder for Health
6. Deodorant
7. No glass containers
8. Put your name on all PE clothes

## ART (All supplies need to stay in the art room)

1. 1 bottle of glue (no glue sticks)
2. 2 or more pencils
3. 1 eraser
4. 1 pair of scissors
5. One round watercolor brush (either #6, #7, #8, or #9)
6. Colored pencils - to be left in the art room
7. Extra fine sharpie black marker (optional)
8. Hand held pencil sharpener
9. White or black painter's marker/pen - 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade only
10. Box of kleenex



## COMPUTER

1. Two pocket folder

## BAND

1. Instrument in good working condition. Percussionists need stick bag and appropriate mallets. (see below)
2. Lesson book from previous year.
3. Nametag on instrument case/stick bag.
4. Accessories needed - Clarinets/Saxophones: several reeds, 2 reed guards, cleaning cloth , Trumpets/Horns: valve oil, slide grease, cleaning kit, Trombones: slide cream, small water spray bottle, tuning slide grease, cleaning kit, Percussion: stick bag, 5B snare sticks, blue rubber mallets, M8 soft yellow yarn mallets
5. Seventh & Eighth Grade Band: flip folder and lyre for marching and pep band music (Percussion only need flip folder) \*Be sure to get appropriate lyre for your instrument as they are all different. \* Please refer to the MMS Band Handbook at <http://ct078.k12.sd.us/> for a complete list of supplies by instrument.

## **ALL 6TH GRADE STUDENTS NEED THESE ITEMS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR:**

1. One 2" binder (velcro closure ) with 6 two-pocket folders or an expandable plastic folder.
2. Two boxes of tissue, 175 count or more, to homeroom teacher
3. #2 lead pencils (10 pack - one per quarter)
